It is my pleasure to communicate with you regarding our experience with Health Navigators and their Cardiovascular Disease Risk Reduction Program

TI Automotive is a global tier one supplier of fluid carrying and fuel systems. In the United States, we have 23 manufacturing facilities employing approximately 6,000 associates. One of those facilities is located in Cartersville, Georgia. We were introduced to Health Navigators through their program with the State of Georgia where one of our facilities is located. After meeting with Peter Townsley and Robbie Burlas and hearing the details of the CVD Risk Reduction Program, we made the decision to implement their program for our Cartersville associates. The results were nothing short of remarkable. Through their program, we were able to identify 32 individuals at high risk for a cardiovascular event and give them the tools they needed to take themselves out of harm's way. At the end of the 8-week program, there were only 3 individuals left in that high risk category.

We have since implemented the program at all of our facilities in the US with similar results. While the program began as an initiative to control escalating health care costs, it has evolved into an initiative to improve the lives of our employees and their families. During this time, we have formed a strong relationship with both Peter and Robbie and find them to be 2 of the most professional and dedicated individuals in their field.
